## **Timothy Richardson** 4 May 2011

Timothy was born and bred in East Surrey and served in the RAF in the 1970's. He joined the Met in 1982 and served in this area, South London and at Scotland Yard. His career was mainly front line policing but he was also in Special Branch and involved through out the late 1980's and 1990's in anti terrorist duties as well. Many hats! For a short time in 1988 he was one of Margaret Thatcher's close protection officers!

Timothy was invalided out of the Police in 1999 after being seriously assaulted rescuing a nurse who had been taken hostage by a mentally deranged man. He now enjoys teaching primary school children about the Surrey home front in 1940 with his HQ in an original Home Guard hut based at a Victorian fort in Guildford.

Timothy is also involved in historical projects with the National Trust in Surrey and Sussex.

## **Kenneth Bare** 25 May 2011

Kenneth is a Trustee and Director of the Surrey Hills Society and also a member of its Management Committee. He joined the Society shortly after he retired in 2008 and helped develop the PR and publications side of the Society - for example by attendance at events, giving talks and being part of the editorial team for the newsletter. Kenneth lives in West Horsley and for many years one of his ways of de-stressing has been to get out into the Surrey Hills to walk and take photographs - some of which you will see in the presentation.

## **Mollie Bonard** 1 June 2011

Mollie is Chairman of Epsom Beekeepers based in Ewell Village. She has only been a Beekeeper for 11 years but she is training to be a National Honey Judge. This involves taking modular exams and many practical ones as well as stewarding at National, County, South of England and local shows. She also judges at local shows as well as exhibiting.

## **Anne Woolf-Skinner** 29 June 2011

Anne is a Holocaust survivor who has lived in the UK since the age of 22 months. She studied music at the Guildhall School of Music. After graduating, Anne taught in many schools in the south east of England and she has enjoyed a lifetime of music-making with pupils, friends and colleagues. She still teaches the piano at home.

Her talk will briefly describe the events in Germany that led to the Holocaust and the subsequent rescue of 10,000 children on the Kindertransports.
